In **carmine** Vergiliī, **scrīptōris** Rōmānī illius, Graecī multās cōpiās contrā Trōiam dūcunt. “Bellum sine ūllā causā bonā aut propter sōlam iram gerere numquam dēbēmus,” Trōiānī cōgitābant; “sed libertātem vitāsque populī sine bellō dēfendere nōn possumus— quārē bellum cum Graecīs erit **necessārium**.” Propter **deōs** Graecī Trōiānōs tum vincere nōn poterant. Ad portās Trōiae, igitur, magnum equum ligneum trahere audēbant; in istō equō erant multae cōpiae Graecae. Lāocoon inquit (*says*), “Nōn estis sānī, Ō Trōiānī— Graecī numquam sunt vērī! Sī cōpiae sunt in hōc equō, in perīculō erimus!” Sed serpentēs malī **Lāocoontem** strangulant, et Trōiānī equum in Trōiam dūcunt. Dum nox est et Trōiānī dormiunt, cōpiae ex illō equō dēscendunt et multōs necant.
